Venue:

West Palace, Beijing China.

Number of Participants:

Due to the length of the course restriction, the number of participants to play should be around 60-70, including Chinese players and overseas players who are volunteering to play in China.

Schedule and Fixture:

28 May, Friday	09:00	Official practice (18 holes)
	12:00	Draw lots in groups for the first 2 rounds (36 holes)
29 May, Saturday	08:30	Players arrive on course
	09:00	The 1 st round (18 holes) tees off (Starting from No.1 Teeing ground, 10 minutes interval among groups, and there will be 30 minutes interval between 9 th hole and 10 th hole for the previous 9 groups.)
	14:30	The 2 nd round (18 holes) tees off. (the starting order is the same as 1 st round)
		Lunch time for players at the course
30 May, Sunday	09:00	The 3 rd round (18 holes) tees off. (The group will be in accordance with the scores of previous 2 rounds. Leading player tees off as last)
		Lunch and prize awards ceremony

Competition regulation:

Tee area	Use of Tee Pegs on the teeing ground is obligatory.
Number of the clubs	Par 3, one must be Putter.
Ranking	The gross score of each round is counted. Players will be ranked in terms with the total scores after 3 rounds.
Playoff	The winner will be decided by Sudden Death. Others ranks: the best 18,9,6,3 and last hole.
Rule	The FIPPA Rules will be applied.
We hope we can invite Mr. Martin Whitelaw from FIPPA as the representative of the event committee. Any controversy during the game or doubt about the rules will be arbitrated by the event committee, and the arbitrage is final.	

Fee:

The inscription fee for international player (including practicing fee, lunch and soft drink) is EUR 30 (or other equivalent currency)

The inscription fee for Chinese players (including practicing fee, lunch and soft drink) is RMB 300.

Should the international player require clubs, the fee will be EUR 10.

Prizes:

1. The best individual 3 Absolute scores will be declared Champion, Sub-Champion and third place winner of the trophy of the Beijing Open.
2. The best individual 3 women will be awarded as Ladies Champion, Sub-champion and third place women's winner of the trophy of Beijing Open.
3. All the participants of this Beijing Open will be awarded an honorary certificate.

Suggested Itinerary A

Day 01/ May 24 (Mon.) -Beijing

(L/D)

Arrival in Beijing, ideally during the morning. The English speaking Guide will meet your flight and assist with your transfer to the hotel and check-in. After lunch (Chinese meal), we will arrange a city tour.

Dinner of Shanxi cuisine in the Jiyang Restaurant near the hotel.

staying at **Beijing Royal King International Hotel** (5 stars)

Day 02/ May 25 (Tue.) Beijing

(B/L/D)

Full day tour to the **Great Wall of China** near **Badaling** (China's Great Wall is the only man-made object visible from satellites and is one of man's most remarkable accomplishments. Construction of the Great Wall began in the 7th century B.C. this magnificent wonder starts at Shan Hai Pass in the east and ends at Jia Yu Pass in the west, stretching more than 6000 km.). After lunch (Chinese meal at the Jindian Restaurant near the Great Wall), we will return to the city and visit Beijing Olympic Venues, including Bird's Nest stadium and Water Cube (outside view).

Dinner of Chinese meal of Local specialty cuisine-Beijing Duck at Jinyafang local duck restaurant.

Day 03/ May 26 (Wed.) Beijing

(B/L/D)

Sightseeing to the **Tian'anmen Square and the Forbidden City** in the morning (Forbidden City is China's most imposing architectural masterpiece). It represents many aspects of China's long history and is the largest museum of oriental art in the world. Located in the center of Beijing, Forbidden City was built between 1406 and 1420. Twenty four emperors of the Ming and Qing Dynasties once lived there. The entire palace covers an area of over 180 acres and boasts over 9000 rooms and halls. Walking through the palace, visitors will have the feeling of passing through a historical corridor.). In the afternoon we will visit **the Temple of Heaven** (Located in the southeast of Beijing, Temple of Heaven was built in 1420. Ming and Qing emperors went there to worship heaven and pray for good harvests each year. Different from the Forbidden City with yellow tiles and red walls, the temple adopts blue as its major colour, suggesting the sky).

Afterwards, if we have time, we can visit the famous silk store—Yuanlong. **Dinner at the Red Revolution Restaurant**, having the country food and enjoy the revolutionary performance representing the former crazy days of Culture Revolution,

After lunch the players will be travel to West Palace **Pitch & Putt** course for practising and the other guests will leave for Liulichang, to see the renowned street of Chinese antique shops. **Dinner of western buffet** at Beijing Jindu Holiday Inn (4-star hotel).

Morning: **II International Beijing Open**. The starting order will be decided according to the handicap system.
